# Pilot Meeting: Community of Practice on Freedom of Religion or Belief in Development

Copenhagen, 27.-28.9.2023

Important achievements have been made in the promotion of Freedom of Religion and Belief (FoRB) as a universal, indivisible human right, but there has been a growing recognition of the interrelatedness of this right to so many other aspects of social change. In the efforts to ensure the attainment of the Sustainable Development Goals, the alleviation of the discrimination and inequalities suffered on the basis of religion or belief, is imperative. This is why there is a growing eagerness to learn more about how FoRB can be effectively incorporated and integrated into more traditional development work.

Members of the NORFORB network have identified a need for faith-based development organisations to come together with donors and academics in a Community of Practice on Freedom of Religion and Belief in Development

CKU together with the NORFORB network would like to invite to a two-day workshop in Copenhagen as a **pilot event** for this CoP on FoRB in Development. The goals of the meeting would be:

- To test the interest and needs of possible target groups for a CoP on FoRB in Development
- To stimulate concrete experience sharing regarding FoRB in Development
- To take first steps in learning together through the development of useful tools for the integration of FoRB in Development with point of departure in community-level FoRB indicators
- To define next steps for the CoP, like creation of specific learning groups or other chosen pathways for continuous work after the meeting

**How:** 2-day workshop with extensive group work as well as input and response to the work done together from FoRB practitioners, academics and global policy leaders.

**What:** We will discuss questions like: How have we tried to integrate FoRB in development projects so far? Which barriers do we experience? How can we measure progress and change at the community level?
