Reduced access to education	Kidnapping
Reduced freedom of movement	Forced conversion
Reduced freedom to associate	Unequal family and other legal rights
Gender selective abortions and infanticide	Restricted access to places of worship
Employment or wage discrimination	Enforced ritual prostitution
Forced divorce	Restricted access to justice
Rape	Restricted participation in political life
Acid burnings	Early and forced marriage
Dowry deaths	Forced pregnancy
'Honour' killings and honour-based violence	Female genital mutilation
Domestic violence	Forced sterilization
Imprisonment for religious or other beliefs and activities	Reduced access to healthcare
Targeting of religious leaders (eg through hate crimes or state sponsored violence)	Coercion from the state, the family, the community or an employer to wear (or not wear) specific dress
Confinement in the home as punishment	Restricted access to religious education/training
Online hate speech	Police or security service harassment
Trafficking	Assault or murder
Verbal and physical street harassment	Isolation from family members/friends
